- Volatile






Logistics and Transportation

Overview of Long Term Air Charter

- ❑ Long-Term Air Charter of Rotary and Fixed Wing Aircraft
- ❑ Unmanned Aerial Vehicles
- ❑ Various Aviation related requirements (Ground Handling services, Satellite Tracking, etc.)
- ❑ Letters of Assist (LOA) negotiations

Transition from ITB to RFP

- From lowest cost technically compliant bid to BVM proposal based on logistical scenarios



Overview on Short Term air charter/road transportation

- ❑ Short term air charter and road transportation services for the Deployment, Repatriation and Rotation of Peacekeepers (passengers) into the theater of operations
- ❑ Short term air charter for VIPs
- ❑ Short term charter services for the airlift of strategic COE (e.g. military helicopters) and UNOE
- ❑ Emergency evacuations of civilians from fighting zones by air
- ❑ Short term ship charter for transportation of COE and UNOE
- ❑ Road Transportation Services for passengers and COE
- ❑ Long Term ship charter and emergency evacuations by sea
- ❑ Market surveys for reimbursement of TCCs under LOAs (air and sea cargo)

In 2017, a total of 244 **tenders** of passenger and cargo movements handled.




Overview on Freight Forwarding Service

- ❑ Freight forwarding service contracts for Door to Door shipments of UNOE, including both airfreight and sea freight.
- ❑ Freight forwarding systems contracts (Courier Services, Household Goods, Cold Chain, etc) and for upcoming Global Freight Forwarding systems contract
- ❑ High value/ high visibility freight forwarding requirements of non-PKM Offices (UNDSS, UNMAS, etc.)
- ❑ Expert advice on freight forwarding to UN Missions/Offices, including for 3PL contracts.
- ❑ Market Surveys for comparison of DAP vs FCA rates

In 2017, approx. 100 multimodal Door to Door UNOE shipments handled.





Engineering/Supply/Food/Fuel and related areas



FIELD SUPPLY (Food and Fuel)

Food Rations for UN Field Missions

- Turnkey contracts for UN Field Missions
- Including import of food rations, warehouse management, outbound distribution, containers, bottled water.



Fuel Supply for UN Field Missions

- Turnkey distribution points, bulk deliveries, commercial stations.
- Jet A-1, Diesel, Gasoline, Kerosene.
- Gases: butane, propane.
- Security reserves
- Oil lubricants

Medical Services and Supply



- Medical equipment, medical and dental consumables.
- Blood Supply.
- Pharmaceuticals and vaccines.
- Commercial Medical Services (Clinics and Aeromedical Evacuation)






