



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SIGNATURE DE LA CONVENTION D'INTERDICTION DES ARMES CHIMIQUES Paris 13-15 Janvier 1993



"A unique multilateral agreement that, alone among treaties of a similar nature, effectively bans an entire category of weapons of mass destruction, for all countries and in a non-discriminatory fashion and under strict international control."



CWC: Bans an Entire Class of Weapons

Prohibits:

- Development, production, acquisition, stockpiling, retention, usage, transfer, or military preparations for use of chemical weapons
- Assisting, encouraging or inducing anyone to engage in any prohibited activity
- Use of riot control agents as a <u>method of warfare</u>










Purposes not prohibited under the Convention

- Industrial, agricultural, research, medical, pharmaceutical or other peaceful purposes.
- Protective purposes, directly related to protection against toxic chemicals and protection against chemical weapons.
- Military purposes not connected with the use of chemical weapons and not dependent on the use of toxic properties of chemicals as a method of warfare.
- Law enforcement: domestic riot control agents (pepper spray, tear gas) non-lethal.

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


