The United Nations Educational, Science and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) hereby invites qualified companies/individuals to submit proposals for the following assignment:

Evaluation of UNESCO's work in Information and Communication Technologies in Education (ICT in Education)

The evaluation requires the following principal qualifications for the team leader/senior evaluator:

- University degree at Masters level or equivalent in education, social sciences, political sciences, economics, or any related field;
- At least 10 years of working experience acquired at the international level or in an international setting;
- Senior experience of at least 10 years in project and/or programme evaluation;
- Knowledge of and experience in applying qualitative and quantitative data analysis techniques and RBM principles;
- Senior professional experience relevant to the field of Education;
- Professional work experience in developing countries or in a national/regional/global development context;
- Understanding and knowledge of the UN mandates and its programming in relation to education in the framework of the Sustainable Development Agenda;
- Excellent analytical and demonstrated excellent drafting skills in English;
- Working knowledge of French;

Furthermore, it is desirable that the evaluation team demonstrates professional experience in ICT in Education and understanding of development needs in ICT in Education, specialist experience in gender and gender sensitive approaches in evaluation, as well as work experience in the UN or experience with assignments for the UN. The evaluation team should **collectively demonstrate expertise and experience in the above areas**, and must have no previous involvement in the implementation of activities under review.

Main deliverables: Inception Report, Field missions, (Draft) Final Evaluation Report.

The evaluation will be conducted between July 2018 and December 2018 and is estimated to take up 70-80 working days.

The purpose of this notice is to provide general information on the requirements for the procurement process and to inform interested suppliers how to obtain a copy of the Solicitation Documents.
