WFP Procurement

The World Food Programme provides food assistance to meet emergency needs and to support economic and social development.





WFP aims to bring food assistance to more than 90 million people in 75 countries.

In 2015, WFP procured over USD 2.6 billion of food, goods and services to support the distribution of approximately 4-5 million metric tons of food.




Food Procurement – Key Roles

- Undertake all food procurement for WFP operations worldwide as well as for third parties such as UN Agencies, Governments and NGOs
- Provide oversight, technical expertize and guidance to all WFP offices to ensure that food procurement is undertaken in a cost effective, timely and transparent manner
- Support the development and implementation of strategies, policies and plans to meet WFP's mandate

- Donor country conditions/restrictions (origin/ destination/quality /packing /marking etc.)
- Recipient country requirements
 (product/origin/packing/import regulations)



G&S Procurement

Contracts with commercial providers are managed by WFP's Goods & Services Procurement Branch*.

- Headquarters at Rome, Italy
- Regional Bureaux at 5 locations worldwide
- Field Offices in 80 countries worldwide

G&S Procurement has always been a core functional area within WFP. Since 2004 the volume of G&S procurement by value has grown by 200%

The G&S Procurement branch procures on behalf of WFP, however, some linked structures like UNHRD also procure on behalf of the wider UN and governmental/nongovernmental agencies.






2010-2015 Procurement G&S


In 2015 WFP Procurement purchased USD587m of G&S.

G&S Procurement – Key Role

- Four Principal Functions
 - Oversee & manage large value G&S field procurement
 - Undertake all G&S procurement at WFP headquarters.
 - Manage all policy guidance and support to WFP offices worldwide;
 - Engage with external clients, when WFP commits to procure on behalf of other UN Agencies/other actors.
- Ensure all G&S procurement is undertaken in a consistent, cost effective and transparent manner respecting the guiding principles of UN procurement.
- Provide procurement expertise to external actors, as required



G&S Procurement – Construction

Construction was 10.7% of WFP's Goods and Services budget in 2015 Construction accounts for the third-largest goods and services spending category. WFP uses its in-house expertise in the areas of logistics, procurement and engineering to successfully carry out numerous construction projects around the globe.

This involves building roads, bridges, airstrips and ports, offices, guesthouses, warehouses, schools and camps. WFP undertakes construction to support the longer-term needs of national governments, the humanitarian community and WFP's own operations. Projects vary in scale and complexity depending on their location, the local context, and scope.





WFP Construction



WFP Ebola response entailed more than 35.5 million USD (2014 and 2015) In response to the unprecedented scale of the Ebola Virus Disease outbreak in West Africa, WFP was heavily involved in the procurement of goods and services to support the emergency response.

To assist the wider humanitarian community, the organization made firsttime purchases of ambulances, treatment units, incinerators and medical beds - items specific to the large scale health response.

These items required Procurement to undertake rapid market assessments and identify suppliers that could quickly fulfil orders to meet specifications. Due to the urgent timelines, WFP often made special arrangements for the transport of goods, including airlifting items when required to shorten delivery time.

ICT – Corporate IT & FITTEST



In 2015 WFP's ICT expenditure exceeded USD 70m WFP's IT Division at its Rome Headquarters is responsible for the establishment, implementation and governance of WFP's IT strategy worldwide. It is supported by IT officers at Regional Bureaux and in WFP Field Offices.

In addition, WFP's Fast IT and Telecommunications Emergency Support Team (FITTEST) is a leader in establishing vital IT and communications infrastructure during emergencies.

WFP is the UN cluster lead for Emergency Telecommunications. FITTEST operates within the cluster.



Requirements to Contract with WFP

- Goods and services are of interest to WFP
- Legal capacity to enter into a contract with WFP
- Has the financial standing to honor a contract
- Has proven ability to perform
- Company has a minimum of three years' experience as an established business
- Company accepts WFP's general terms and conditions, including its payment terms



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
