About the UNGM

The United Nations Global Marketplace – UNGM – is the common vendor database for the UN system.

It brings together **UN procurement staff** and the **vendor community**.

Registration on UNGM is a **requirement to participate in tenders** from more and more UN organizations.

All companies are welcome to register on UNGM. Individual consultants are also able to register.



What are the benefits?

Registration on UNGM is free of charge.

Vendors can register with **29 UN organizations** which use UNGM to source vendors.

These organizations account for 99% of the total annual UN procurement spend.

Vendors have access to a large amount of information including **business opportunities**.

UNGM provides an excellent **opportunity** to introduce your products and services to many UN organizations, countries and regions by only completing **one on-line registration form**.



How do I register?

It takes approximately **5 to 10 minutes** to complete the Basic level registration.

- 1. Create an account at www.ungm.org
- 2. **Complete the registration form** and automatically register with the UN organizations matching your vendor's profile


The website is available in multiple languages.

You can find around **500 active notices** at any one time.
