UN General Assembly resolution 302 (IV) of 8 December 1949

Mandate

UNRWA is mandated to provide relief, human development and protection services to Palestine refugees and persons displaced by the 1948 hostilities, as well as subsequent hostilities.

> Mandate renewed every three years

The mission of UNRWA is to help Palestine refugees achieve their full potential in human development.

Palestine Refugees


Palestine refugees are people whose normal place of residence was Palestine between June 1946 and May 1948, who lost both their homes and means of livelihood as a result of the 1948 Arab-Israeli conflict





Descendants of original Palestine refugees are also eligible for registration. There are today close to 5 million Palestine refugees registered with UNRWA.

Education

> 685 schools

- > 21,924 educational staff

> 9,457,155 Annual Patient Visits

Relief and Social Services

- > 292,000 people benefit from social-safety net
- > 61 women's programme centers.
- > 37 community-based rehabilitation centres.
- > Maintains records of Palestine refugees

Microfinance

> 398,154 loans since 1991

US\$ 440.4 million in loans awarded

> 33% to youth (18 – 30 years old)

> 38% to women

UNRWA's Procurement and Logistics Division (PLD) is responsible for the procurement, distribution and provision of all food, goods and services required to support almost five million Palestine refugees in all of UNRWA's areas of operation.

UNRWA has its own organizational model of "supply chain" where PLD manages the whole business end to end – from requirement through to handover to beneficiary – which creates a very flexible scalable resource

- International Procurement is mostly carried out by the Procurement and Logistics Division at Headquarters (Amman)
- Local Procurement and some International Procurement is carried out by the Procurement and Logistics Departments located in the Agency's five Fields of operation

UNRWA regularly procures:

- School textbooks
- > Maintenance services
- > Pharmaceuticals
- Consultancies and professional services
- Equipment -such as medical and lab, ICT
- Vehicles & Transport Parts
- Basic Food Commodities including flour, rice, sugar, powdered milk and canned Sardines






