  - Countries procurement profiles



- The ASR is published on a yearly basis and is released mid-June after coordinating the submission and revision of reporting UN organizations procurement data.






## **Total procurement of goods and services 2009-2017**

- Total procurement volume increased to \$18.6 billion in 2017; an increase of 5.1% from 2016 volume.
- Procurement of services increased by \$823M to \$9bn and constitutes 52.8% of UN procurement in 2017.
- Procurement of goods increased by \$87M to \$8.7bn.



## **Top 25 supplier countries by procurement value, UNOPS 2017**




- The top ten supplier countries in 2017 accounted for \$7.4 billion (or 40.0 per cent) of the total UN procurement value.
- The top ten supplier countries included two European countries (Belgium and France), with a combined supplied value of \$1.4 billion, 7.6 per cent of total UN procurement value.

## Distribution of UN procurement by sector



- The five largest sectors of procurement (excluding other goods and services) accounted for 79.7 per cent (80.1 per cent in 2016) of total procurement in the UN system in 2017.
- The sectors are: (1) Consultancy, administration and operations; (2) Health; (3) Transport; (4) Food and farming; and (5) Construction and engineering.
- Other goods and services sector that refers to UNSPSCs® that are not within the previous categories, totalled \$2,796 million for 2017.
















































## **ASR online tool – procurement by UN organization**








