In 2018 WFP procured 3.5 billion USD

The entire UN system procured approximately 19 billion USD in 2018

The World Food Programme (WFP) is the leading humanitarian organization fighting hunger worldwide and working towards the global goal of ending hunger by 2030.

WFP has been delivering lifesaving food in emergencies since 1962. We also work in recovery and sustainable development.

WFP is funded entirely by donations from governments, companies and private individuals.





## GLOBAL COMMITMENT

Adequate nutritious food is a basic human need. We believe it's also the foundation of a full and dignified life.

- We reach an average of 80 million people with food assistance in around 80 countries each year.
- We have unrivalled experience operating in the world's most difficult environments, both war zones and disasters.
- More than **15,000 people** work for WFP. Most are locally recruited staff who work in remote areas, directly serving the hungry poor.



## HUMANITARIAN LOGISTICS

WFP's supply chain logistics expertise helps many humanitarian organizations reach people in need.

• We manage the United Nations Humanitarian Air Service (UNHAS).

WFP flies approximately 300,000 humanitarian workers and 3,000 tons of cargo to some 290 regular destinations.

- We manage the United Nations Humanitarian Response Depots (UNHRD), a network of six strategically located emergency hubs around the world dispatching approx. US\$45 million in relief supplies to some 95 countries.
- We provide Logistics Services directly to the humanitarian community. For example, the World Health Organization chose us to provide logistics and engineering services for them during the Ebola Outbreak in West Africa.



## WORKING TOGETHER

WFP works in partnership with national and local governments, other humanitarian agencies and the private sector.

We lead the humanitarian **Logistics and Telecommunications Clusters** to help coordinate humanitarian response. We co-lead the **Food Security Cluster** with the Food and Agriculture organization of the United Nations (FAO).







## FOOD DISTRIBUTIONS

When food is not available on local markets, or people cannot get to the shops, we deliver food to them. We work with local NGO partners to organize the distributions.

Foods provided can include:

- Flour/rice/bulgur
- Lentils/split peas
- Cooking oil
- Iodized salt

To prevent and treat malnutrition we provide specialized nutritional products formulated for particular nutritional needs.

## **KEY ROLE**









- Undertake all international food procurement for all WFP operations worldwide as well as for third parties such as UN Agencies, Governments and NGOs
- Provide oversight, technical expertize and guidance to all WFP offices to ensure that food procurement is undertaken in a cost effective, timely and transparent manner
- Support the development and implementation of strategies, policies and plans to meet WFP's mandate
- Review and authorize all food procurement actions from the field above the authority of field offices

- Donor country conditions/restrictions (origin/ destination/quality /packing /marking etc.)
- Recipient country requirements (product/origin/packing/i mport regulations)
- Impact on local market/economy (harvest/lean period/surplus)

How to do business with WFP? **Types of relationships** 

## **Commercial Relationships**

- Contract (one-off) Legal Agreement for provision of specific goods and services for defined cost within defined timeframe.
- Long Term Agreement Framework contract for the provision of an unspecified volume of Goods and Services (G&S) to WFP over a defined period of time.

#### **Non Commercial Relationships**

 Partnership – Collaborative relationships, not based on commercial grounds, that achieve positive outcomes for the people we serve
